

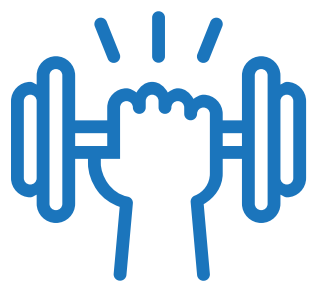
IEP CHEAT SHEET

WHAT IT IS:



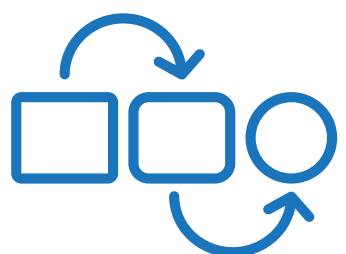
Legal document

Provides accommodations



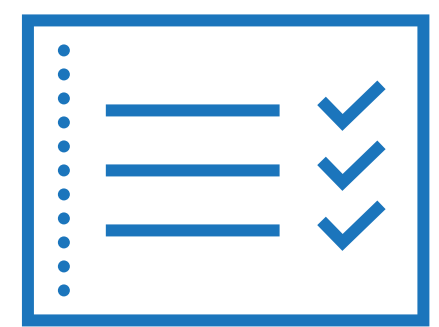
Outlines modifications by subject

WHY IT'S IMPORTANT:

- Acts as a voice for you and your child.
- Meets your child where they are, and ensures grades and comments are based on their specific goals.
- Legally entitles your child to the agreed upon support.



LOOK FOR:



When needed, there will be Program Pages that outline modified programming. Check to ensure the plan fits the needs and that the report card reflects the program. Talk to your child about how they are being accommodated.

HOW TO ADVOCATE:



- Be sure to complete the Parent Consultation Form to have your voice present on the plan.
- Stay in regular contact with the teacher. Your partnership is your biggest asset.
